Learn more about and enjoy the natural world of Strathcona Park through our workshops and guided hikes for people of all ages and fitness levels

- Saturday July 1st 9:30AM 12:00PM Paradise Meadows Early Spring Blooms SWI research student Inza Maki will lead this easy walk around the Paradise Meadows and Centennial Loop trail (3.5km) identifying early spring blooms of the subalpine. Limit 15.
- Sunday July 2nd 1:30PM 4:00PM Old Growth Logging near Strathcona Park
  Jay Van Oostdam will present a series of films on the effects of old growth
  logging, followed by a walk displaying where such logging is taking place
  adjacent to Strathcona Park. Limit 35.
- Saturday July 8th 10:00AM 3:00PM Paradise Meadows Plant Identification \$25 registration fee Naturalists Loys and Alison Maingon will lead this workshop focusing on subalpine plant identification around Paradise Meadows. Limit 15.
- Sunday July 9th 10:00AM 3:00PM Lake Helen Mackenzie Loop Guided Hike CDMC Member and avid hiker Janet Beggs will lead this easy hike around Lake Helen Mackenzie and Battleship Lake (8.5km). Pack a lunch. Limit 15.

  ornithologist Eve Kenny, Conservation Area Interpreter with Birds Canada Limit 35.

  Expert botanist Jocie Brooks will lead this easy-to-moderate hike (10k) to Lady

  Lake, featuring a lovely wetland area. Pack a lunch. Limit 15.
- Saturday July 29th 8:30AM Mt. Allan Brooks Guided Hike
  Avid hiker Dave Weaver will lead this strenuous hike (15km) up Mt. Allan
  Brooks featuring steep sections and route finding. Pack a lunch. Limit 15.
- Sunday July 30th 9:30AM to 12:00PM Paradise Meadows Subalpine Trees

  Naturalist Fred Newhouse will lead this easy walk around the Paradise Meadows
  and Centennial Loop trail (3.5km) identifying trees of the subalpine. Limit 15.

Unless otherwise indicated, all hikes and presentations start from and take place at Strathcona Park Wilderness Centre, Paradise Meadows.

Sturdy footwear is essential - be prepared for sudden weather changes in the mountains.

Always carry water. No dogs, please.
